Evangelistic Praying

1 Timothy 2:1-8

Prioritize It

1 Timothy 2:1 First of all, then, I urge that entreaties and prayers, petitions and thanksgivings, be made on behalf of all men,

Evangelistic praying means putting it as one of your top priorities for your church.

Learn It

1 Timothy 2:1 First of all, then, I urge that entreaties and prayers,
petitions and thanksgivings, be made on behalf of all men,

Evangelistic praying for the lost is biblically multi-dimensional, it is not vain repetitions.

Broaden It

1 Timothy 2:1 “...be made on behalf of all men”

Evangelistic praying has a broad scope, it's very inclusive.

Narrow It

1 Timothy 2:2 “for kings and all who are in authority, ...”

Evangelistic praying while broad in its scope, also gets very specific.

Believe It

1 Timothy 2:3–6 — 3 This is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, 4 who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth. 5 For there is one God, and one mediator also between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, 6 who gave Himself as a ransom for all, the testimony given at the proper time.

Evangelistic praying is God & Christ-centered, it embraces this kind of praying as praying in the will of God.

Pay-attention to It

1 Timothy 2:4 who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

Evangelistic praying discerns that God is actively at work in the saving of souls.

Multiply It

1 Timothy 2:7 For this I was appointed a preacher and an apostle (I am telling the truth, I am not lying) as a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and truth.

1 Timothy 2:8 Therefore I want the men in every place to pray, lifting up holy hands, without wrath and dissension.

Evangelistic praying asks God to raise up evangelists and evangelistic prayer warriors.

Purify It

1 Timothy 2:8 Therefore I want the men in every place to pray, lifting up holy hands, without wrath and dissension.

Evangelistic praying replaces wrong attitudes with great love in reaching the lost.
